GETTING INTO MINISTRY S.H.A.P.E.

Here at our church we believe in CONNECTIONS. We want to first of all see people CONNECT to GOD, then CONNECT with us the people of God, then CONNECT with their MINISTRY PLACE, and then finally CONNECT with PEOPLE JUST LIKE THEM so they might bring them into CONNECTION with GOD. Do you see the pattern forming?

Discovery is always a part of the pathway of CONNECTION and there is just something exciting about making discoveries!

Wednesday nights at 7:00 PM in room #101 we have revamped a little the way we do things and we believe you will like what we are up to! We have a time of praise and worship, a time of praying through scripture, and then a time of training.

We will be spending a maximum of EIGHT weeks on a topic and for the next six weeks we are engaged with the idea of "Getting into Ministry S.H.A.P.E." The SHAPE acronym stand for: Spiritual Gifts, Heart, Aptitude, Personality, and Experience. We are already filling out Spiritual Gifts Analysis and coming to understand just how it is that God has gifted us for our particular role that we play in the Body of Christ.

Once we know our role then we can CONNECT into the place of ministry that we are SHAPED to fit.
